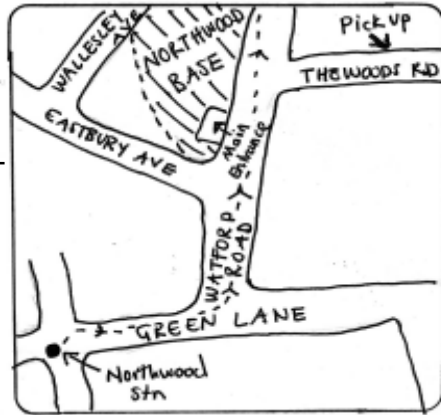


No More Fallujahs- *Peace Journey*

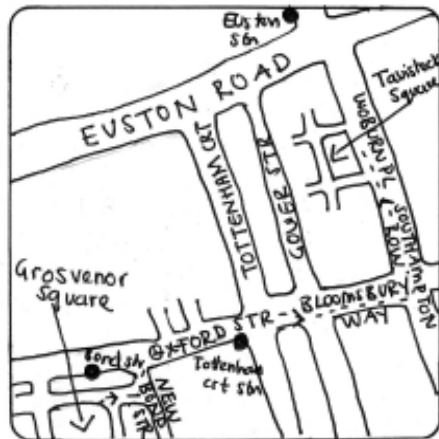
Northwood- Grosvenor Sq- Tavistock Sq

Northwood host the British Permanent Joint Forces Headquarters (PJHQ), which is responsible for all British operations overseas. All British forces involved in the war on Iraq- whether in aircraft taking off from airbases in the UK, Kuwait, or anywhere in the world, or tanks deployed in the desert as part of the land war- are, ultimately, commanded from Northwood. It is at the heart of the military machine that we protest today.

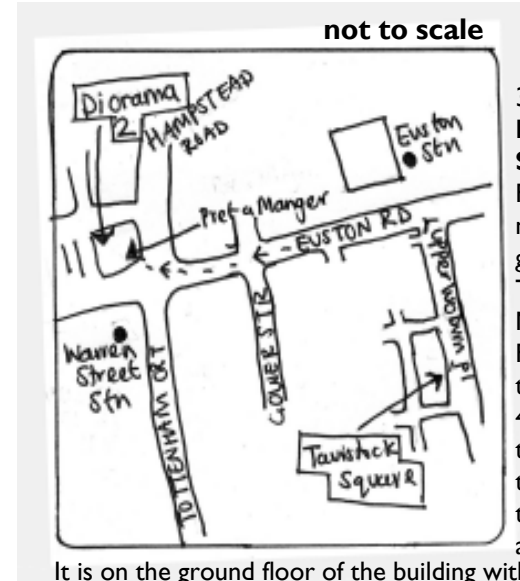
- 11am Meet Northwood Tube Station
- 11.30 Leave for base in single file procession on the pavement
- 12 Reach front entrance of the base
- 12-1pm March around base
- 1pm Symbolic tying of names to the fence at main entrance
- 1.30 Leave promptly from pick up point on The Woods Road



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1.30-2.30 Arrive at Marble Arch. All to go to Grosvenor Square*

- 3pm Arrive at Grosvenor Square for the US Embassy (nearest tube Bond Station).
- 3.10 March via Oxford Street, down Bloomsbury Way then left onto Southampton Row to Tavistock Square
- 4pm Tavistock Square, Gandhi statue. (nearest tube Euston).

From Tavistock Square walk north to Euston Road. Keep going until Tottenham Court Rd. Then turn right after Pret-A-Manger.

From Warren Street station exit the station and turn left to face 40-storey Euston tower. Cross the road heading towards the tower. Turn left in front of the tower, carry on, and turn right after Pret-A-Manger.

It is on the ground floor of the building with the 4-storey, pop art, electric fan painting. Look for the doors beneath the sign that reads D3.

***n.b.** The drop off point in London is Marble Arch, a 10 minute walk from Grosvenor Square. Hopefully we will travel together on this stretch, but if you do get lost at Marble Arch, travel East along Oxford St turning right onto North Audley St which leads onto Grosvenor Square and the US Embassy.

This event has been organised by the **Mass Action Group** as part of the '**No More Fallujahs**' weekend of action 28-29 October 2006. We want to remember the atrocities of Fallujah 2004 where at least 700 people lost their lives in a US onslaught -which was supported by the UK- forcing tens of thousands of people to flee their homes, and using white phosphorus- a substance that burns down to the bone- as a weapon. The city itself was almost entirely destroyed. We are marching today to say **No More Fallujahs**.
